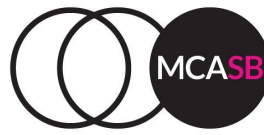
Application Deadline

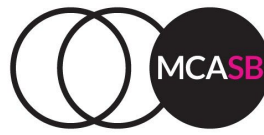
